- _____ Boots & 2nd pr. of Camp shoes
- _____ Notebook & Pen & (B.S.A. Handbook)
- _____ Compass
- _____ Sleeping Bag; warm for winter use,
- _____ Bag liner or blanket (for x-tra warmth-optional)****
- _____ Foam Pad or approved winter mattress (no air mats)
- _____ Mess kit & Silverware
- _____ Toiletries (tooth brush, tooth paste)
- _____ Water bottle (non leaking tops)
