Provide a stamped addressed envelope for each request of a letter of recommendation.

Instructions to Letter Writer: This letter of recommendation should focus on your personal interaction with the Eagle Scout candidate and should take into consideration your observation of how he exemplifies the points listed below in the Scout Oath and the Scout Law. You may use the space provided, or you may attach a separate sheet. Please send your letter to the Pikes Peak Council office in the envelope provided by the candidate.

The letter should not be given to the Scout. Thank you for taking time to write this letter.
